Biblical Timeline

1447 B.C. – Israel’s exodus from Egypt (**Exodus 7:1-14:31**)



1053 B.C. – Saul is anointed as Israel’s first king (**1st Samuel 9:15-10:25**)



1011 B.C. – David is made king over all of Israel (**2nd Samuel 5:1-5**)



971 B.C. – Solomon becomes king of Israel (**1st Kings 1:5-2:12**)



967 – 960 B.C. – Solomon builds the Temple of the Lord (**1st Kings 6:1-38**)

Biblical Timeline Cont'd

931 B.C. – Kingdom of Israel is divided in two (**1st Kings 12:1-24**)



721 B.C. – Assyria carries Israel away into captivity (**2nd Kings 17:5-41**)



606 B.C. – Battle of Carchemish (**Jeremiah 46:1-26**)

1st Jewish deportation to Babylon (**2nd Chronicles 36:5-8, Daniel 1:1-7**)



597 B.C. – 2nd Jewish deportation (**2nd Kings 24:8-16**)

Biblical Timeline Cont'd

592 – 570 B.C. – Ezekiel prophesied to exiled Jews (**Ezekiel 1:1-3**)



588 B.C. – Jerusalem is besieged by Nebuchadnezzar (**2nd Kings 25:1-5**)



586 B.C. – Jerusalem, and the temple, is burned down (**2nd Kings 25:6-21**)

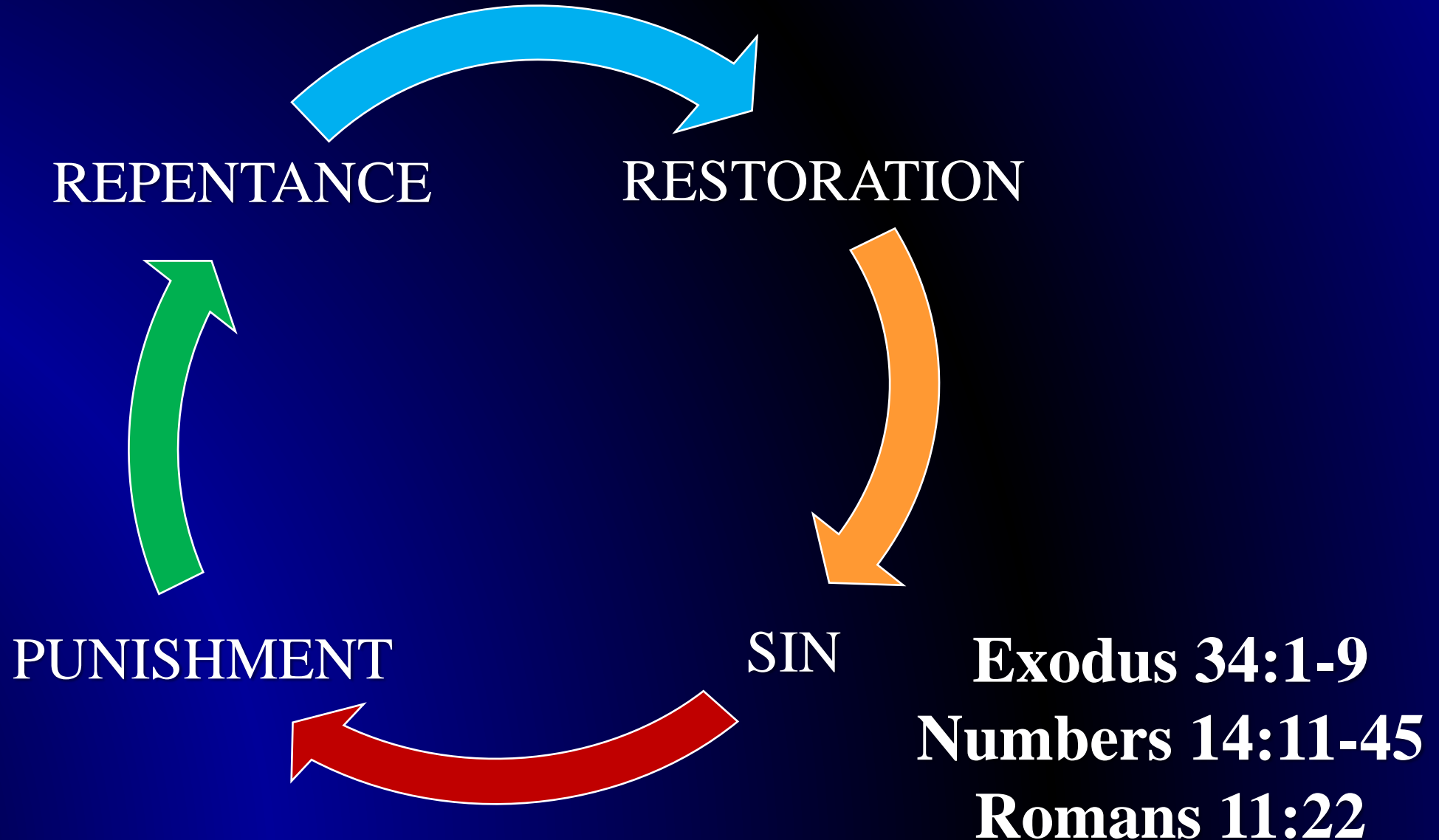


585 B.C. – Exiled Jews learn of Jerusalem's destruction (**Ezekiel 33:21-22**)



573 B.C. – Ezekiel prophesizes Israel's future restoration (**Ezekiel 40-48**)

- Given a scroll to eat (**2:8-3:3**)
- Four living creatures (**1:5-14**)
- Rainbow around the throne of God (**1:28**)
- Marking of the saved (**9:3-6**)
- Burning of the city (**10:2, 6-7**)
- Fall of Tyre & Babylon (**26-28**)
- The tabernacle of God among the people (**37:27-28**)

Revelation

- Given a little book to eat (**10:8-11**)
- Four living creatures (**4:6-9**)
- Rainbow around the throne of God (**4:3**)
- Sealing of the saved (**7:1-4**)
- Burning of the city (**8:5-6**)
- Fall of Rome (**18**)
- The tabernacle of God among the people (**21:1-4**)

...continued

Ezekiel

- Gog & Magog (38:18-23)
- Ezekiel shown a vision on a very high mountain (40:2)
- The new city is measured (40:3-5)
- 12 gates with the names of Israel's tribes (48:30-35)
- The river of healing waters (47:1-12)

Revelation

- Gog & Magog (20:7-10)
- John shown a vision on a great & high mountain (21:9-10)
- The new Jerusalem is measured (21:16)
- 12 gates with the names of Israel's tribes (21:12-13)
- The river of life (22:1-5)
