

We pursue many things, but none as worthwhile as the will of God.





The Futility of Mind



We must drink the cup Jesus drank, and in return we shall receive much more in this present life, and in the age to come eternal life (Lk. 18:28-30).


No Ordinary Pursuit








The great challenge to overcome evil with good requires the best from us, and Jesus demonstrated what it takes (Jn. 16:33; Mt. 7:13-14).

Jesus Overcame The World Therefore, be imitators of God as dear children. And walk in love as Christ...


The term "imitate" has reference to mimicking, as a child would during their formative years. We must resemble the character and conduct of Jesus Christ.



We are warned that evil company corrupts our moral standards of right and wrong (1 Corinthians 15:33).


Therefore, we must guard our hearts lest the wicked one overtakes us.

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

Though God has the ability to take 12 men and turn the world upside down, this can only be accomplished by carrying out His will and not ours!




From Weakness to Greatness


